**COMING WEDNESDAYS APRIL 21 - MAY 19, 7 - 9 PM**

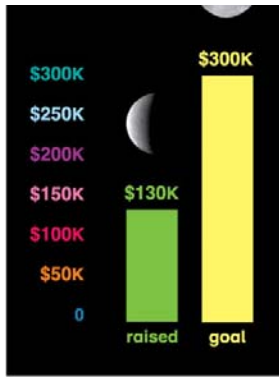
